Maundy Thursday, March 29th at 7:00 PM

Tenebrae (Latin, for "shadows") is a service of darkness that retells the story of the last hours of Jesus' life—His arrest, trial and crucifixion. The Gospel is read, along with other readings, music, video and lighting, all coming together in a very moving and meaningful service. "Come trace the steps the Savior walked for you." It will make Easter Sunday all the more glorious!

Six Hours One Friday

Good Friday, March 30th – 9:00 AM – 3:00 PM

The Sanctuary will be open between the hours of 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM (the hours that Jesus hung on the cross). Drop in anytime on the half-hour. Take your time; stay as long as you like. There will be a brief introduction with instructions given every 30 minutes. This is followed by a self-guided rotation that includes music, images and hands-on stations. This is an excellent time for some intense, personal reflection including a special multi-sensory experience and retelling of Jesus' crucifixion—an important part of our Good Friday remembrance.
